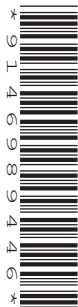

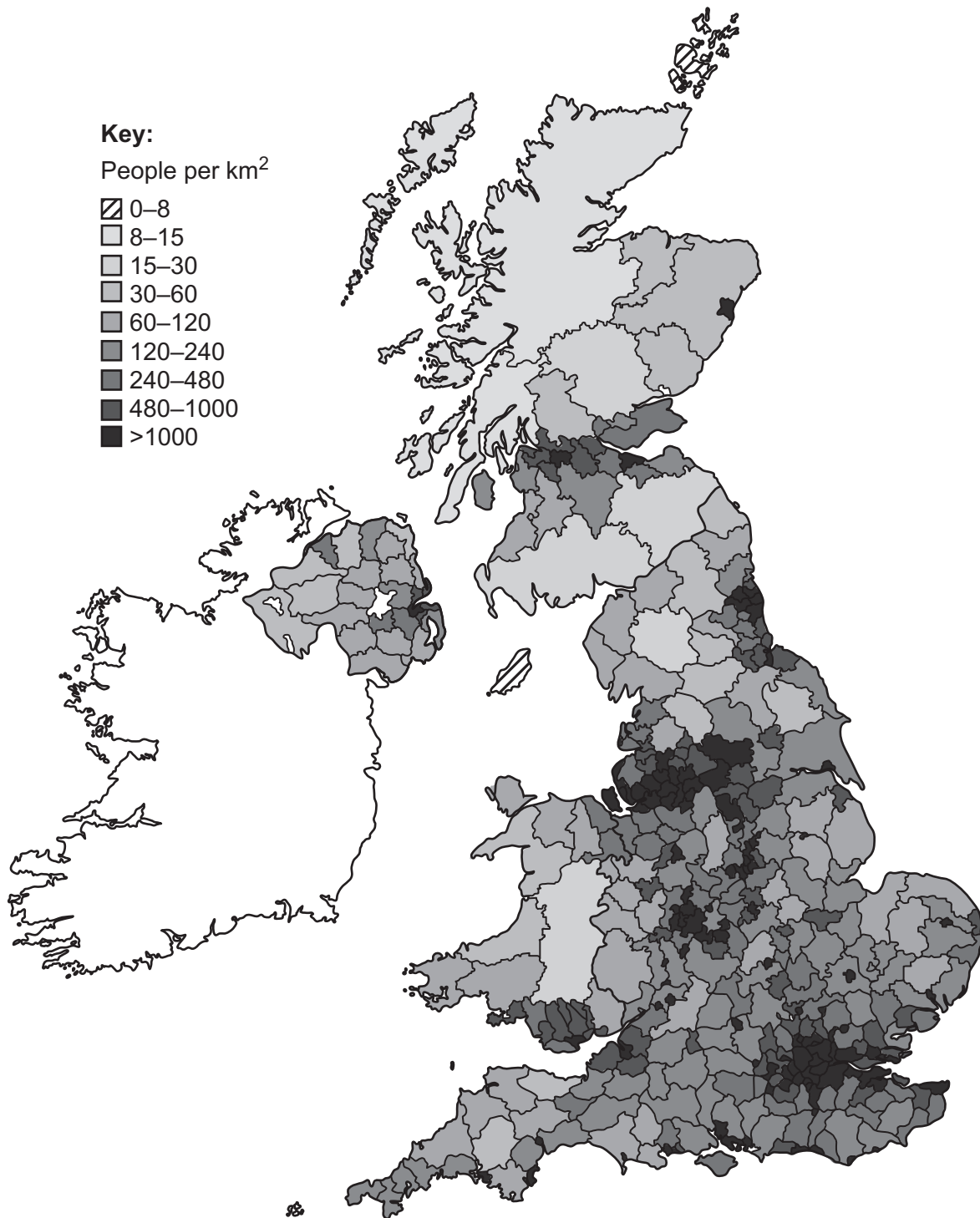

## Population density map of the UK



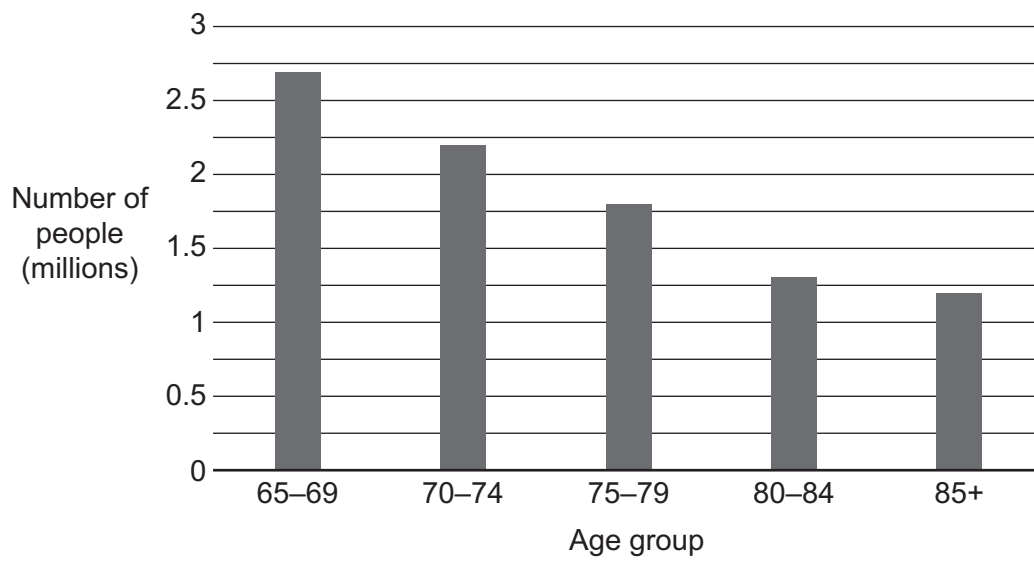
**Fig. 3****Number of people in each age group over 65 in 2011 UK census**

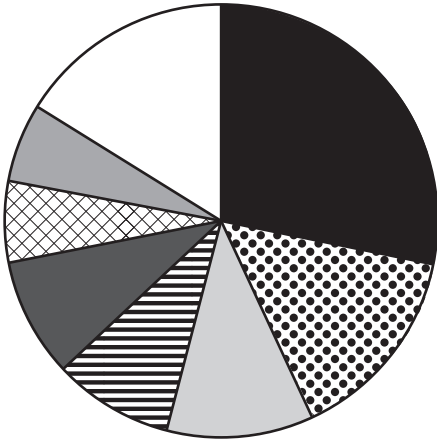
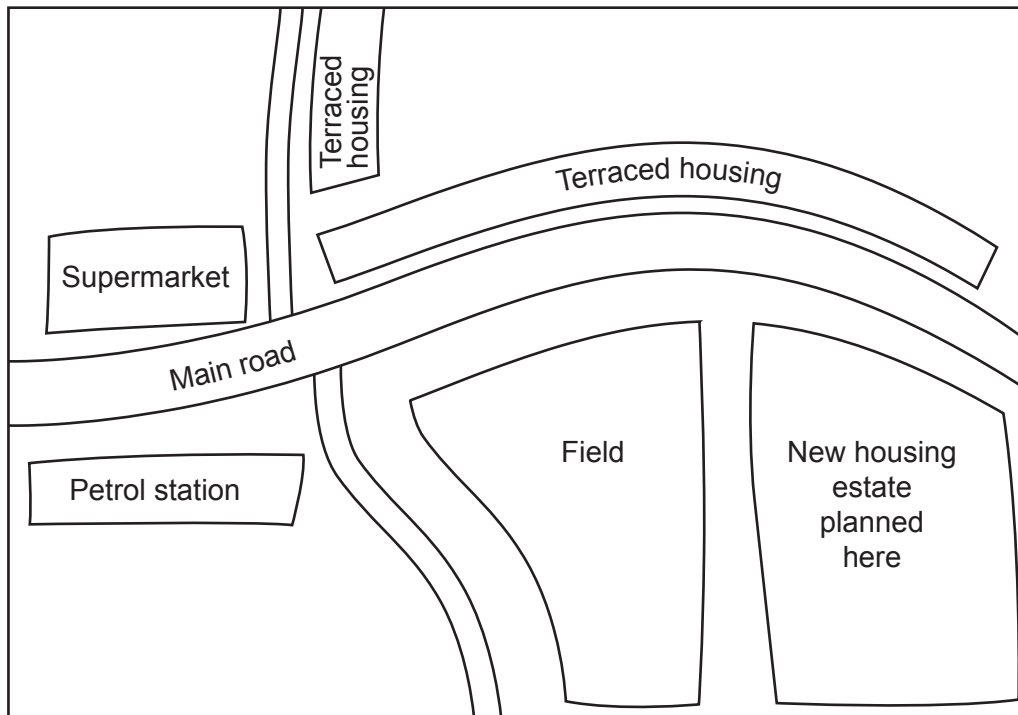
**Wasted food and drink in the UK****Key:**
